

PRODUCTS FROM THE PETROJAM REFINERY



The Petrojam Refinery is a 36,000 barrels a day Hydroskimming plant, which produces the full range of products, needed by Jamaican consumers. Crude oil for processing is purchased under Government to Government agreements with Venezuela and Mexico and from Ecuador on an 'ad hoc' basis.

Products Manufactured

- LPG Cooking Gas:** - used for heating, cooking and making plastics
Gasolene: - 87 and 90 Octane grades of unleaded petrol
Jet Fuel: - for domestic and international airlines serving Jamaica
Kerosene: - to power two stroke engines and tractors
- Automotive Diesel & Gas Oil:** - used for diesel vehicle engines and to operate power generators
Heavy Fuel Oil: - used for industrial asphalt in two grades- Penetration and Emulsion for road construction

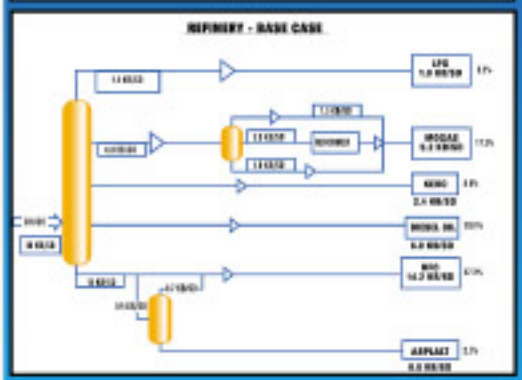
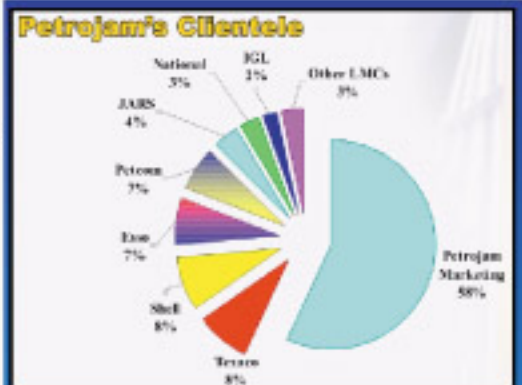
